Read the case "Darwinians at the Gate: sustainability, innovation and growth at DSM"

Questions:

- 1. What motivates DSM to engage in a sustainability-oriented strategy?
- 2. What type of innovations are required to deliver that strategy? And what observations do you observe (using information from the case and company website)?
- 3. Considering the sustainability stages of Nidumolu et al. (2009) discussed during the introduction lecture, where would you position DSM and why? Provide at least three arguments supporting your choice?
- 4. Compared to their main competitors, where would you position DSM (both in term of sustainability performance and financial performance)?
- 5. What would be the next steps for DSM to further implement their strategy and increase their sustainable performance?
- 6. What are according to you the key lessons in this case?
